## TUCKER BUSINESS ASSOCIATION ANNOUNCES MAIN STREET GROUNDBREAKING



**Main Street Tucker will undergo a complete transformation**

**TUCKER** – The Tucker Business Association (TBA) is pleased to announce the official ceremonial groundbreaking for the Main Street streetscape upgrades.

A ceremonial groundbreaking marking the event will be held on Main Street on **Wednesday, December 1, at 10:30 a.m.** The event will be free and open to the public.

Wider sidewalks will be installed on both sides of Main Street to make the area more pedestrian friendly and the road will be reduced to two lanes from its present four. These improvements will not require the sacrifice of parking spaces.

Honey Van de Kreke, co-manager of the Main Street Tucker Alliance (MTA) and vice president of TBA, says that during the upgrades, special consideration will be paid to existing business on Main Street. “Of course there will be some disruptions, but we have been assured that the contractors will only work on one side of the street at a time, and that access to existing businesses will be maintained throughout the project.”

“We’ve been working on this for 10 years, and we are very excited that this is finally under way,” Van de Kreke added.

**About TBA:** More than 50 years ago, TBA was established by local corporations and independent professionals to promote and enhance the Tucker business community. Monthly breakfast meetings are held on the third Thursday of each month at 7:15 a.m. at Matthews Cafeteria on Main Street in downtown Tucker. The cost of breakfast is included in the \$125 annual membership dues.
